## Invitation to *Meanwhile Hydrosiren* launch on the Grand Union Canal

**The Canal & River Trust and Modus Operandi are delighted to invite you to a special inaugural launch of a floating, acoustic sculptural artwork by Simeon Nelson at Meanwhile Gardens, Kensal Town.**

Created by artist Simeon Nelson, this unique 'singing boat' takes its inspiration from the inhabitants of Meanwhile Gardens, the canal and local community.

*Meanwhile Hydrosiren* has been commissioned by the Canal & River Trust – the charity that cares for the canal – and curated by Modus Operandi, to celebrate one of the capital's best-loved urban community gardens.

The art boat will be punted along the Grand Union Canal to Meanwhile Gardens from Little Venice from 3pm on 14 October and play a soundscape by composer Rob Godman with live performance by soprano Elizabeth Karani.
